## Home Care Services

Provides a range of basic maintenance and support services to help eligible older people, younger people with disabilities, Australian veterans and war widows / widowers to be more independent and remain living at home longer.

Services include:

- ◆ domestic assistance

- ◆ home maintenance

## Seniors' Support Service

Provides a range of services to the older members of the community to empower them and work with them, the community and services providers to implement a range of innovative solutions to:

- ◆ loneliness, social and physical isolation
- ◆ fear of crime and risk of elder abuse
- ◆ access to information and technology
- ◆ financial constraints of low income
- ◆ impact of significant life events

## Housing and Community Services

Co-ordinated organisational and agency tailored support provided for families and individuals who require assistance in areas such as:

## Community Visitors Scheme

Provides friendship and a link with the community for residents of the Nursing Home and Aged Care Hostels. This program involves regular visits by volunteers.

## Burdekin Centre for Rural Health

Delivers a range of health programs:

- ◆ *Rural Industry Lifeskills:* face to face counselling sessions, group education
- ◆ *Health Promotion and Injury Prevention:* group education, activities and information for adults and children
- ◆ *Centre Facilities:* for a wide range of visiting allied health services
- ◆ *Transport:* to access health and wellbeing appointments in the Burdekin and Townsville
- ◆ *Fitness for Whole of Life:* individualised exercise programs, Tai Chi and LifeSteps classes for adults
- ◆ *Information and referral:* for health and wellbeing related services operating in the Burdekin and Townsville.

## Burdekin Community Rehabilitation Centre

Provides clients with fully supervised exercise sessions including monitoring heart rate and blood pressure. Healthy lifestyle education and information sessions are also conducted to enable clients to develop a happier, healthier, risk free lifestyle.

## CORES Program

Community Response to Eliminating Suicide, is a community based program that teaches community members, how to recognize and help someone who may be suicidal.
