Community Support
Services Program

What is the Community Support Service?

The Community Support Service aims to assist those in the Burdekin community who may be experiencing hardship and crisis and to help them to improve and sustain their quality of life.

Services

Community Support Service provides the following range of services:

- ◆ Advice, advocacy and referral services
- ◆ Community living support and community development activities
- ◆ Local and regional service provider collaboration and coordination
- ◆ Access to information and technology
- ◆ Culturally and Linguistically appropriate service support and/or referrals
- ◆ Non-judgemental and inclusive service environment

Who is eligible?

All members of the Burdekin community who are experiencing a hardship in their lives are eligible to apply for assistance through the Community Support Service.

Hardships may include:

- ◆ Financial difficulties
- ◆ Emotional and mental stress
- ◆ Family issues
- ◆ Limited community interaction
- ◆ Lack of/or limited social interaction skills

Limited eligibility

The Community Support Service is funded by the Queensland Department of Communities. Funding received for the program is confined to access by Burdekin residents, according to the funding agreement.

How Do I get access to Community Support Services?

You, a family member or a friend can contact the Community Support Services' workers to arrange an appointment for an assessment of your needs.

Can I access additional support services?

You have the right to access additional support services through Burdekin Community Association. These services can include:

- ◆ Housing and Homelessness Service
- ◆ Emergency Relief Program
- ◆ Domestic and Family Violence Court Support and Support Services
