What is the Housing and Homelessness Service?

The Housing and Homelessness Service aims to aid families and individuals in the Burdekin community who are experiencing homelessness, are at imminent risk of homelessness and/or are seeking information, advice or advocacy on matters regarding housing and homelessness.

Services

Housing and Homelessness Service provides the following range of services:

- ◆ Information, advice and advocacy on behalf of clients, in regards to housing matters
- ◆ Liaison with government and non-government agencies on behalf of clients, in regards to housing matters



What is the Crisis Housing Program Service?

The Crisis Housing Service provides short and medium term crisis housing to families and individuals who are homeless or at imminent risk of becoming homeless.

Services

The Crisis Housing Service provides the following services:

- ◆ Short and/or medium term housing
- ◆ One on one weekly support visits
- ◆ Transition from crisis housing to permanent long term housing

How do I get access to the Housing and Homelessness and Crisis Housing Programs?

You, a family member or a friend can contact the Housing and Homelessness workers to arrange an appointment for an assessment of your needs and eligibility.

Limited eligibility

Both the Housing and Homelessness and Crisis Housing Programs are funded by the Queensland Department of Communities Housing Service. Funding received for the programs is confined to access by Burdekin residents, according to the governing funding agreement.

Can I access additional support services?

You have the right to access additional support services through Burdekin Community Association. These services can include:

- ◆ Community Support Services
- ◆ Emergency Relief Program
- ◆ Domestic and Family Violence Court Support and Support Services
